Mollie Grace Dalton Scholarship

Born in Mill Spring, North Carolina on July 20th, 1896, Miss Mollie Grace Dalton came to Granite Falls in 1928 to teach at Granite Falls Elementary School. Miss Dalton received her teaching certificate from Brevard Normal School, now known as Brevard College. She earned her BS from East Carolina University and began her long teaching career. During her teaching tenure, she was known as a stern but fair and loving teacher. At the time of her retirement at age 76, Miss Dalton had the longest teaching record in the state of 52 years.

Miss Dalton belonged to the Granite Falls First United Methodist Church. She served on several Committees including the Nominating Parsonage Committee and the Administrative Board.

Miss Dalton took a trip every summer and shared her experiences with her students and friends. She traveled around the world two times as she continued to travel after she retired. Miss Dalton was a well-known and much loved member of the Granite Falls Community and enjoyed her life in the community as teacher and leader. She lived until the age of 98 and shared her estate with students enabling them to attend college on her scholarship.

About the Scholarship

The Education Foundation of Caldwell County offers a scholarship each year for students graduating from South Caldwell High School. While students planning on pursuing any major can apply, those entering the field of education will be given preference.

Criteria for scholarship

Students must

- 1. be graduating from South Caldwell High School
- 2. have a weighted 3.0 GPA or higher
- 3. include the following:
 - a. completed application
 - b. official transcript
 - c. sealed letter of recommendation (not from a friend or family member)
 - d. typed essay stating why you want to attend college & how the scholarship will help you achieve your goals

Scholarship applications are due to South Caldwell High School Senior Counseling office by **March 1 of each year**. Late applications will not be considered. The winner will be recognized on Senior Awards Day.
